

Training Requirements for School Bus Mechanics in Ohio

The state of Ohio requires school bus mechanics to have 4 hours of training annually. The Ohio Pupil Transportation Operation & Safety Rules, section "School bus mechanic training" lists the specifics on what training is to cover. This training can come from sources other than the Ohio School Bus Mechanics Association annual meeting. Some larger school districts hold their own training sessions or send mechanics to training offered by school bus manufacturers.



School Bus Mechanic Training Requirements

"The Ohio School Bus Mechanics Association was formed over 25 years ago on the premise of educating the school bus mechanics in Ohio. Over the years we have had over 1,700 school bus mechanics as members, providing pertinent training in many areas.

We feel it is most important that school bus mechanics remain current in their training in an age of continually changing technology.

School bus mechanics have a wide range of responsibilities including handling breakdowns and making repairs, scheduling and documenting preventative maintenance, parts purchasing and inventory control, "specing" new buses, prompt attendance to voluntary or mandatory vehicle or equipment recalls, to compliance with a range of OSHA and environmental regulations.

Constant technological innovations have made ongoing professional development an absolute necessity for school bus mechanics."

Ohio Pupil Transportation Operation & Safety Rules Section 3301-83-10

(D) School bus mechanic training—Each school bus owner shall provide the opportunity for school bus maintenance personnel to participate in an annual workshop or training seminar, with a minimum of four hours of instruction, in one or more of the following areas:

- (1) Preventive maintenance procedures
- (2) Repair procedures for each type of vehicle in the fleet and its special equipment:
- (3) Servicing procedures for equipment;
- (4) Inspection of the vehicle and its equipment;
- (5) Recovery procedures for vehicles involved in an accident or breakdown;
- (6) Preparation of maintenance records;
- (7) Parts and equipment purchasing and storage;
- (8) Establishment of parts inventory control procedures.

It is recommended that all school bus mechanics in Ohio keep a file of all documents, certificates, and receipts verifying that you have met this annual training requirement. From a liability standpoint, this is essential for both the mechanic and the school district/employer.


