

School Bus Mechanic of the Year

Cracking Floor Cross Members

Do you have older Amtran or IC buses? There have been some issues on some units with the floor cross members cracking at the frame attaching points. Until now the only repair was to try to weld the crack and hope it didn't reappear, or to try to make a reinforcement yourself and install that.

There is an easy solution to this problem from IC and it works with all three mount types—J bolt, U bolt and mounting ear type mounts. There is a left and right part number: 452456000 LH and 4524560002 RH. It is a heavy angle that sits in the cross member that has all the holes for the mount positions. To install, simply remove the mount bolt and clean the mounting area. Set the angle in the floor channel and stitch weld it to the floor and weld the existing crack. Coat with undercoating and the repair is factory approved and will stop any further issues.
