

Local Business Receives State Commendation

FREMONT, Ohio (Tuesday, Nov. 4, 2014) –After working for the Fremont City Schools for five years as a mechanic, Bobby Sears found his passion was working on buses assuring safe transportation for the drivers and passengers.

So, in 1989 Bobby and his wife, Kellie, founded Bobby's Truck and Bus Repair in Fremont. Little did the couple think that small beginning would lead to expansion and accolades 25 years later.

"I've always liked to figure out why something wasn't running right and that sense of accomplishment when you use knowledge and hard work to fix something," said Bobby.

But Bobby and Kellie still weren't done. In 2013 Bobby's Truck and Bus Repair became the exclusive dealership in Ohio for Lion Bus, an innovative new school bus with many "firsts" in features in the industry.

While Fremont remains the home base for Bobby's Truck and Bus Repair, the Toledo location was referred to as "one of Toledo's greatest accomplishments in small business" by Deputy Toledo Mayor Paul Syring on their recruitment of an international product – the Lion Bus. Bobby's also graced the cover of the Toledo Development News/Business Journal and Economic Development publication as a feature story this year.

The OSBMA Executive Committee proposed a change in the wording of the By-Laws and Constitution to include a representative from OAPT – Ohio Association for Pupil Transportation if they are willing to participate. This was approved by the members of the association and will take effect July 1, 2015.

Section 8. Executive Committee

There shall be an Executive Committee composed of all elected officers and Regional Directors. The immediate Past President of the association, the Political Liaison, and the Newsletter Editor shall be ex-officio, non-voting members. The Director or his/her designee of the Ohio Department of Education shall be automatically on the Executive Committee as a non-voting ex-officio member. The Captain, or his/her designee, of the Ohio State Highway Patrol's Office of Licensing and Commercial Standards shall be a non-voting ex-officio member of the Executive Committee. The Director or his/her designee of the Ohio Association for Pupil Transportation shall be a non-voting exofficio member of the Executive Committee. The Executive Committee members who are actively supporting the association by holding at least one regional workshop and attending at least two executive committee meetings per year shall receive a 100% reduction in workshop fees.

ASE Master School Bus Technicians


