

TIPS & TRICKS


It's SUMMER TIME! School's out and inspections are almost done. These Big Yellow Buses get to take a three month break. Most of us probably do not have a climate-controlled garage for each bus in our fleet, so the summer days do take a bit of a toll on them. Here are a few tips I have found that helps to keep your buses from breaking down while just sitting in the lot.



I went to open entry door after a bus was sitting for 3 weeks. The door opened kind of hard, then...snap...crack! Yep. Entry Door Pivot broke. Well it worked fine when the Bus Driver opened and closed it 100 times a day for 9 months. The weather, outdoor elements and just sitting not in use, I believe had a big factor in this part failing.

It could have been a little rusty...maybe...but when stuff just sits around, bad things happen. I wanted to try and prevent that from happening again or at least slow down the process. I took a can of PB Blaster and sprayed every lower pivot and bushing on all the buses. I could tell, like anything you lube, it opened much easier.

Another thing I like to do before school is out is have the drivers top off their fuel and add a bottle of diesel fuel additive. I use Alliant Power UltraGuard that has stabilizer in it. I figure if the fuel tank was full it would have less room for moisture to condense on the inside of the tank and keep it from rusting.





Most of the summer we are jockeying buses in and out of the garage for routine maintenance or cleaning. I try to start them at least once every couple of weeks and move them around a bit. Doing this will give the batteries a chance to get a good charge, get the internal engine components lubed up and keep the back brake shoes from rusting or locking up! No matter what we do to keep things working properly the summer months always seem to give us a few issues when the first day of school rolls around, but it doesn't take long to get back in the groove for another nine months.


