MECHANIC II NATURE OF WORK AND QUALIFICATIONS

Assist in the repair, servicing and maintenance of school buses and other motor vehicles. Must have high school diploma or equivalent. Must hold or obtain a current Ohio Commercial Driver's License marked "S" endorsement for performance of job duties. Two years' experience as an automotive mechanic preferred. Must have ability to operate diagnostic software; comprehensive understanding of standard repair methods for all types of motor vehicles; general understanding of standard repair methods of all types and makes of school bus chassis and other motor vehicles; general knowledge of charging systems, battery ignition, general wiring and other components; some knowledge of sheet metal work and painting; ability to diagnose trouble in motor vehicles and equipment; working knowledge of principles for safe, expedient and economical operation of automobiles, buses, and other motor vehicles.
