

It's been thirty years—time for an upgrade! The Ohio School Bus Mechanics Association wants your input on the new logo design. The contest is open to all active members of the association.



# TIPS & TRICKS

It all started with a weird rattle under the hood on a 2013 Blue Bird Vision. After doing some investigating, I found that one of the radiator isolators had separated and was no longer doing its job. Just looking at the isolator you couldn't tell it was broken, but as soon as I lifted up on that side of the radiator, I could see it was bad. The first time I changed one of these was while installing a new radiator. It was obvious that it was bad as I removed the radiator—half of the isolator came off with it! Now I check these by lifting up on each side of the radiator every oil change. They are very easy to change if you are replacing the radiator, and I recommend changing them if you have to replace a bad radiator.

If you have to change just an isolator I have done it two different ways. The first time I removed the belt, cooling fan (fan and mount) and fan shroud. The hardest part is getting to the bottom nuts that are on the under side of the frame. The top nuts are easily accessible as you can see in the pictures below. The second one I changed I took the air cooler off the back of the radiator and was able to get to those hard to reach bottom nuts in half the time compared to trying to get to them from the fan side. I hope this helps or saves somebody a little time if you run across this issue.

#### AMERICA'S BEST SCHOOL BUS TECHNICIAN—STATE COMPETITION


