

It takes a lot of time to check a bus over, inside and out before inspection. Here are a few **TIPS** while getting your fleet ready for spot or annual inspections. We have 20 buses in our fleet and a newly asphalted parking lot so I can lay on my creeper and roll down the line checking brakes, exhaust, tires, basically the whole undercarriage. I want to make sure that on inspection day I'm not changing any parts that are going to take a lot of my time. If your drivers are doing a good pre-trip inspection you should not even have to check lights, heater motors or loose seat bottoms. It's amazing how you can write a note on the board about a possible spot inspection and all of a sudden buses are swept clean and drivers flock to you with issues that need attention. I feel I have a good relationship with our inspectors. They know I care about the safety of our kids and drivers and it shows on inspection day. I enjoy learning new things from our inspectors, after all, they spend as much time in and under a bus as we do! So here are a couple things I ran into this past spot inspection, maybe it will help someone else along the way!

JOUNCE BUMPER OR BUMP STOP

Help suspension components from the jolt or sudden impact that occurs when a vehicles suspension bottoms out.

Here is the part#: 0100836; cost is \$5.84.

GUN STICKERS

If the red out line around the gun is faded they will ask you to replace it. If you are out of stock take a red Sharpie and freshen it up!




