

I brought my car to a mechanic and asked him, "Do you have any idea why my car is humming?"


He replied, "Probably because it doesn't know all the lyrics".

TIPS & TRICKS

Here is a tip if you are dealing with a Cummins 6.7 EGR code or noticing a lack of boost power. I have recently had two buses with different symptoms end up having the same problem.

Fig. 1 below shows an intake manifold (EGR and differential pressure sensor are bolted to the top of this). Over time soot builds up and will eventually clog these small ports.

You can see in Fig. 2. the port is completely clogged. Depending on the year of the engine there are different ports with set screws that can be removed for cleaning. Its not a bad job, I recommend taking the entire manifold of (which is only 6 bolts after the EGR has been removed) I take tip cleaners and small brushes to clean out all ports. I will also use some brake cleaner and shop air to be sure all ports and passages are cleaned.
