

### How long have you been a part of the OSBMA?


My involvement with OSBMA has been presenting Cummins technical sessions since 2017 at many of the region meeting and also the yearly meeting.

# TIPS & TRICKS



FALL HAS QUICKLY CAME AND GONE,
OLD MAN WINTER IS KNOCKING ON THE DOOR!
TIME FOR SOME COLD WEATHER PREVENTATIVE
MAINTENANCE.

HERE ARE A FEW ITEMS THAT SHOULD BE DOUBLE-CHECKED THIS TIME OF YEAR!



- 1. **BATTERIES** No surprise this is probably the most important part of the vehicle. If you have a battery that is close to extinction, I recommend changing it before winter. It may last in summer months but the cold will kill it fast! You can also check alternator output.
- 2. **BLOCK HEATER** —We all know what happens when this part is bad. Your engine needs this extra boost of heat during the winter months. You can check these with a multimeter along with the extension cords!
- 3. **FUEL AND WATER SEPARATORS** These filters catch all sorts of nasty gel. They need cleaned / changed before winter. No reason to ware up a bowl of gel soup! Find a good fuel additive and use it.
- 4. **COOLANT** Make sure it's filled to the correct line and check the freeze point. If you want to stay warm the cooling system has to be to the full mark!
- 5. Of course we can't forget **TIRES, WIPERS, BELTS AND HOSES!** No matter how prepared you are, break downs will happen. It seems like more than ever things are made to break, and that's job security I guess.

If you can check these items off your list, you will be ahead of the game this winter!




