

I stopped and opened it up to find a foot inside..



# TIPS & TRICKS

Remember the good old days when all you needed to fix things were some vice grips, WD-40 and a hammer?

Ok, maybe you needed a couple other tools to get the job done.

With advancement in the school bus industry, I feel like I use my diagnostic software more than any other tool in my box! Cummins Insight is a great tool, and pretty much a necessity when owning a Cummins Engine. I'm sure most of you have this software and know how to use it; but for those who do not, here is a little info.

I have had Insight for about 7 years and I am still learning all the different functions it has. The one thing I have been using as of lately is the ECM calibration tool. You must have the paid version of Quickserve and Insight MRHD PRO. Those two yearly subscriptions cost about \$1,500 a year. Your Cummins dealer will charge just under \$300 to update your ECM, so it was a no-brainer for us to do it ourselves. (With \$300 x 5 buses and you have already got your moneys worth. If I update 10 buses a year that's \$3,000 at their dealership plus time and travel, anyways you get the idea.) It's a great feature to have. I had some buses that were 4 or 5 updates behind and throwing all sorts of weird codes. Quickserve showed me which ECM calibration to download, and told me the fault codes it would help resolve. I have had a lot less check engine lights with up-to-date ECM calibrations.

There is also the Inline Mini. I have been told it works as a code reader, and with the Guidanz app you can update your ECM as well. For those who are interested in any of these products call your local Cummins Dealership. You can also call Michael Tillotson with Cummins @ 812-344-3793.


