

TIPS & TRICKS


Can somebody tell me why engineers make the big bucks? Every now and then I come across an issue with a bus that could have been avoided.

This is a 2017 All American but the issue must span from 2017 to present because our new 2023 All American has the same issue. If you have one of these units open the front cover to access the radiator and look at the purple shifter cable to the right. This cable has been installed tightly between two metal brackets. I had a driver tell me they were having problems shifting their bus out of neutral.

After checking the linkage at the transmission (everything was good) I happened to follow the routing and saw that it was pinched between the two metal brackets. Once I removed the cable I was able to see where it had been rubbing to the point were the cable was exposed.

The picture below to the left shows how the cable is routed from factory. The picture to the right shows how I routed the cable after I replaced it. The middle picture shows the cable after rubbing on the metal bracket.
