TIPS & TRICKS


It was the last day of school and I got a call from Bus #16 saying he was stuck at the rail road tracks and could not move. Luckily it was just around the corner from the garage. As I hopped on the bus I saw the Range Inhibit light illuminated. Thinking he just didn't have his foot firmly on the brake while shifting, I tried with no luck. It was a 2017 All American with about 70 kids ready to start their summer.

After checking a few things around the brake pedal and shifter linkage I had the Bus Driver check to see if the brake lights were working., and they were not. Ok, now were on to something. I checked the fuse and relay panel, found a brake light relay (R36) swapped it out with a different one and PRESTO. The range inhibit light went off and the bus was back in drive. I have had a bunch of issues with these relays from high beam headlight, brake lights and even some SCR issues. I have 4 sister buses like #16 so I have and extra relay in the fuse panel for each one incase it fails again on the route.




