You just won a million dollars! What's your first purchase?


First, a case of beer! Then flowers for my wife and pay off the house.

TIPS & TRICKS

Do you remember the first time you changed oil on a Roush V8 Godzilla? Of course you do, because when it was time to fill it back up with oil, you had some choice words for the engineer that picked the location, angle and cap size!

So here is a simple, easy, inexpensive solution! Grab a transmission funnel and cut 2 inches off the bottom of the spout. Next take the funnel to your vice and gently compress it in place. Take your heat gun and slowly begin to warm up the funnel about 3 inches from the bottom. This will allow you to put the perfect bend in it. Take it to the bus and make sure it fits properly. If not, give it a little more bend. Just like that—easy, no spill refill!


